


From 2010 to 2020: Perspectives

- 10-thousands of Non-Austrian-Residents as Plasma Donors: from Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia.
- Partly, Payment with little Restriction & Control: the financial remuneration itself (covered by law as a lump sum). BUT: Welcome-Bonus, Loyalty-Bonus, Bring a Friend-Bonus.
- Opening of brand new Plasma Centers, Market Consolidation (Humanplasma, Plasmapunkt), Scaling-Up Collection, Emotionalisation in Marketing Approach – Patient driven approach, etc.

... it depends ...

- Donor Potential of a Country itself : absolut number of donations
- Relation of Blood : Plasma Donations as such
- Donation Frequencies as such
- If payment: Appropiateness (relation to average income level)
- Density of Collection Centers (Example: Distance 100 km, Int. Meeting: "We haven't observed a Crowding-Out-Effect at all ...")
 - Opening a Plasma Center just around the corner of an established Blood Collection Center
- Socio-Cultural Determiners (Incentives, see Sanquin Research, etc.)
- Awareness of the need of donation

... but what can be told about Austria from 2010 to 2022 ...

- Number of Plasma Centers and Donations went up
- Bonus-Systems for Plasma Donors were introduced
- Financial Remuneration went up
- Plasma Centers: Canibalisation & Consolidation
- Marketing Effort for whole blood donation tripled (Vienna Region)
- Donor Potential for new whole blood donors went down: Demographics,
 Eligibilty Criteria & Donor Protection, Competition from Plasma Centers
- Important: from 2010-20 the Demand in Red Cells went down!
- Demand in Red Cells 2020-30?



Outlook 2030: What does it need? What will it still need?

- European Self-Sufficiency PLUS
- Fair and balanced collection within Europe (Minimum & Maximum)
 - Few countries carry the Burden (Austria, Germany, Hungary, etc.)
 - Operative Power in Collection in non-performing or underperforming countries
- Strong Guidance and Engagement of EU Institutions and Health Ministries
- Adequate Regulation and Control: on European and Member State Level
- Donor Protection: Health and Safety for the Donors
